

# Steelworkers Inflatable Fun Carnival

## **Volunteer Guidelines**

1. Always wait for instructions from the attendants.
2. Always wear your volunteer vest to identify that you are supervising and please remember to return them at the end of the event.
3. Notify the attendant immediately if you get injured and complete the necessary accident reports.
4. The inflatable units weigh as much as 800 pounds, so you must practice safe lifting principles.
5. We use super dollies to move our equipment and again they are heavy and are meant to have two people move them around.
6. Never try to move a unit by yourself.
7. Wear suitable clothing. You will get dirty and you will need to bend over to set up and take down the units.
8. Bring a lawn chair and sunscreen. It's a long day!
9. When staking the units be aware that the stakes spin and there is a need to be aware of cable ties and washers also spinning.
10. We use electric drills so please ensure that you have ample cable to reach the spiral anchors during set up and take down.
11. When supervising the participants, be sure to enforce the safety rules posted at each ride and follow the minimum and maximum height restrictions.
12. If a unit that you are supervising starts to deflate, move the people to the exit quickly but calmly. Send someone to get the licensed attendant.
13. Never fall on a deflating unit to speedup the exhaust of air as it will not hold your weight and there is a high risk of injury.
14. The United Steelworkers and the Fun Carnival attendants shall not be held responsible for injuries that may result through your volunteering at this event.
